Filing Deadline	12:00 Noon, January 27, 2015
Primary Election (If Needed)	March 3, 2015
General Election	April 7, 2015

CANDIDATES DECLARATION OF INTENTION

Complete the "Candidate's Declaration of Intention" (Form CS). The form should be signed in the presence of the City Clerk Karen J. Logan at the time of filing. All candidates must file in person.

STATEMENT OF SUBSTANTIAL INTERESTS FOR LOCAL OFFICE

Every candidate must complete this form, preferably submitted at the time of filing. Form must be received by the city clerk no later than 10 days after the filing deadline – February 5, 2015.

AFFIDAVIT OF EXEMPTION FORM (see instructions on form)

This affidavit can be filed by any candidate who does not anticipate taking in or spending \$500 in the primary election and \$500 in the general election. The candidate will file the affidavit with the county election officer. If the candidate fails to file this affidavit prior to February 23, 2015, he/she must then complete the Receipts and Expenditures Report.

ITEMIZED STATEMENT OF CAMPAIGN RECEIPTS & EXPENDITURES

If the candidate receives or expends more than \$500 in the primary election or \$500 in the general election these forms must be completed and filed with the county election office.

APPOINTMENT OF TREASURER OR CANDIDATE COMMITTEE FORM (City only)

A first class city commissioner candidate must appoint a treasurer or candidate committee not later than 10 days after becoming a candidate. Governmental Ethics Commission (www.kansas.gov/ethics) will mail packet directly to the candidate.

FILING FEES OR FILING BY PETITION

- ✓ **\$10.00** filing fee (*Check made payable to the Leavenworth County Clerk*) or
- ✓ **Petition Filing:** KSA 25-2110(c) – 50 qualified or not less than 1% of the ballots cast and counted at the last general city election, whichever is less. 1,869 ballots cast in April 2013 General Election – 19 qualified signatures required (*Do not pay the \$10.00 filing fee if filing by petition*)
- ✓ **Leavenworth City Only \$35.00** fee to Governmental Ethics Commission for all Leavenworth City Commissioner candidates. (*Check made payable to the Leavenworth County Clerk*)
- ✓ **Leavenworth City Only** - A first class city commissioner candidate must appoint a treasurer or candidate committee not later than 10 days after becoming a candidate and filed with the Leavenworth County Clerk.
- ✓ **All Candidates Must File** with the Leavenworth City Clerk at City Hall, 100 N. 5th Street, Leavenworth, KS

Leavenworth City Commission has three seats that must be voted upon in the General Election on April 7, 2015:
